PLANT A QUEUÑA TREE

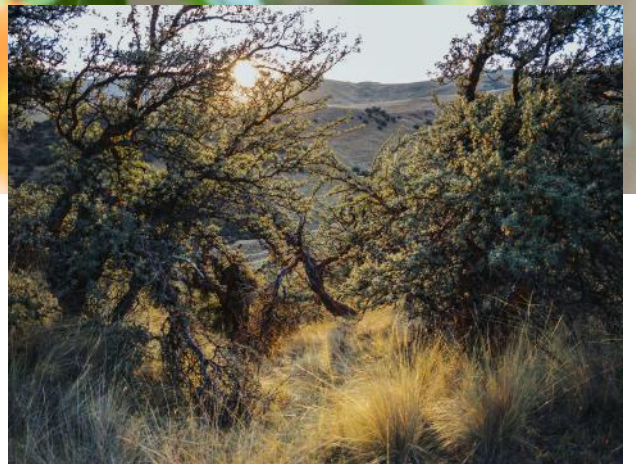
